

### **Conditions of Entry**

1. Neither WES nor the proprietors of Myerscough College will be responsible for any loss, damage or expense incurred to any person, animal or item at the show from whatever the cause arising. All entries are at the sole risk of the competitor.
2. All objections must be in writing to the show manager and be received on the day of the show accompanied by a £10 deposit, which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
3. The organisers, at their own discretion, may at any time, before, or during the show, reject any entry whether the same has been accepted or not and their decision in this respect, without giving a reason, shall be final. The organisers shall have the power to eject from the showground any person whose behaviour they consider objectionable.
4. All competitors must have third party horse insurance and by entering are stating that they have such insurance in force.
5. All competitors must be members of the Western Equestrian Society to compete in WES approved classes and must be conversant with the rules of the society. Neither the Society nor the organisers will be held responsible for the failure of any competitor in understanding the rules.
6. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
7. No unauthorised person may enter a ring including collecting rings.
8. No refunds will be made unless a Vet's certificate or Doctor's note is supplied.
9. Youth competitors under the age of 14 MUST wear a BS approved hard hat fitted with 3 point harness at all times when mounted or competing in Showmanship. Youth riders 14-19 may wear a western hat subject to a disclaimer signed by a parent or guardian handed to the secretary before the start of the youth's first class.
10. Riders choosing to wear a western hat do so at their own risk and must have completed an indemnity form.
11. Vaccinations must be up to date and administered within the last 6 months of the show date. Boosters and 2<sup>nd</sup> of the primary vaccination course acceptable. Completed 14 days clear of arrival at the venue.

### **Health & Safety**

The organising committee will take all reasonable steps to ensure the Health & Safety of spectators, competitors and everyone else present. For these to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions given by the organiser and stewards

### **Directions to Myerscough College**

From M 62 - junction go north on the M61 & join the M6 From M6 - leave Motorway at Junction 32 signed for A6 and M55. Do not take M55 but stay in Lane for A6 and follow the signs for Garstang (not Preston!) Follow A6 north through Barton until you approach Bilsborrow and the turning for Myerscough College is signed on your left. Turn left for the college and continue until you see the main entrance for the college. Horse boxes do **not enter here** but continue a couple of hundred meters around the corner and enter at the Nursery entrance. Follow the signs for the Equine Unit, which is at the back of the campus.

# DECLARATION OF INDEMNITY AND ACCEPTANCE OF RISK

## WEARING OF PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR AT WES EVENTS

The human head is very vulnerable and may suffer considerable damage owing to injuries caused by a fall or impact from a horse. Injuries to the head may have long term effects and in some cases can be life threatening. It has been proven that wearing a correctly fitted, good condition riding hat can protect the wearer from injury or reduce the overall effect of any impact or injury. The Western Equestrian Society promotes safe riding and competition and in order to further this aim strongly recommends that protective headgear to approved standards is worn while handling exercising riding or competing any horse or pony.

### DECLARATION

I am aware of the risks involved in riding or competing without a solid and unbroken properly fitted BSI-approved riding hat or helmet bearing the CE mark and certified to BSEN1384/ BS PASO15 or ASTM-F1163/SEI or above and with the straps properly adjusted and fastened. I understand that the Western Equestrian Society (WES) permits competitors without protective headgear to handle exercise ride or compete horses at their own risk subject to submission of the relevant disclaimer below

#### Adult Competitors

As an adult aged 18 years or over I hereby confirm that I accept full responsibility for not wearing protective headgear to the standards specified above while attending WES events. Having taken this decision I hereby indemnify WES against all losses including but not limited to loss of income and all types of indirect or consequential loss that may be suffered or liability which may accrue to WES as a result of any injury suffered by myself as a result of not wearing appropriate safety headgear while handling exercising riding or competing.
