### **RULES & INFORMATION**

#### **Entries**

ALL ENTRIES forms to be emailed to [socialapp@aphcuk.org](mailto:socialapp@aphcuk.org) BUT VIDEOS can be uploaded to YOUTUBE with link sent with entry form or sent vial messenger via ApHC UK Face Book Page.

Entry fee - £1 per image / video per category. Payment via PayPal, BACS or Chq. Details on entry form.

Entries CLOSE 12pm midnight 5th August, Judging commences 8<sup>th</sup> August.

All entries must complete an entry form, one entry form per horse.

#### **HAT DISCLAIMER \*\*\*\* IMPORTANT \*\*\*\***

Under the rules of Western riding disciplines, it is permissible and appropriate for riders to wear a Stetson type hat rather than a hard hat, any photographs featured in our photo competition in a show environment where riders have signed a disclaimer to ride at their own risk will be accepted but any other disciplines including hacking must feature riders wearing a British standard hart hat or they will not be entered.

All ridden or in hand video entries require RIDING HATS, ApHC UK take no responsibility for your personal safety whilst creating your videos. You do so at your own risk. If you choose to wear a Stetson, your signature on the entry form is a disclaimer. NO SIGNATURE – NO ENTRY.

#### **Images**

If submitting photos taken by someone else - PLEASE get permission.

If submitting professional images – PLEASE credit them and do not submit watermarked images.

Turnout and tack are based on the Class description.

The same image can be entered in all eligible categories. Eg. A 15yr old “A” registered mare show jumping picture can enter Category USA - A, UK- A & B, Female and Veteran.

The same horse can be entered in different Classes, but the horse must be relevant to its category.

Standing still picture means a stationary horse weight bearing on all four legs.

Still picture means a clip (action picture) from a video.

#### **Videos**

**All videos submitted must NOT be over 3 minutes long.**

Please PRACTICE FIRST and submit the best video clip, you can take as many practice videos as you wish until you are satisfied, before submitting your final clip.

Trial your camera on portrait and landscape, ensure the judge will be able to view the specific detail of any PATTERN.

Be aware your video will record voices – say NO more!

Should you require ANY HELP editing such video clips, please contact us. You can send to Paula Cooper’s messenger and we can edit the clip you require and load to YouTube if this helps you.

#### **Membership**

All entries must be made by current 2020 members of the ApHC UK.

All classes are for ApHC UK & ApHC (A, B, PB and C registries) registered horses - PAST & PRESENT.

All classes for OTHER BREEDS must be owned/submitted by a current 2020 ApHC UK Member.

Day Membership is available to compete at each show for £10 per person. Please request a day membership form.

**ApHC UK 2020 MEDALS** - All Category placings are to 6<sup>th</sup> place, points will be awarded to each placing.

Points system - 1st = 50pts, 2nd = 40pts, 3rd = 30pts, 4th = 20pts, 5th = 10pts and 6th = 5pts.

Members who achieve 100 points or more (combination of all three shows) will receive an ApHC UK 2020 Medal.

**Medal winners will receive them after the Champion of Champions Show in October (including Day Members).**

All results shall be announced 14 days after the show date and be published. We have added a tick box on the entry form if you DO NOT wish your picture and or video to be published but please remember this is a great for Appaloosa promotion.

### **Show details**

All entries will be forwarded to the Judge via email "WE TRANSFER" and videos via YouTube link. The Judge will only have your horse's allocation number (back number) for reference, the back numbers will be allocated to your horse once your entry form has been received. **PLEASE REQUEST YOUR BACK NUMBER BEFORE SUBMITTING ANY VIDEO LINKS TO YOUTUBE. Then forward the link.**

The judge will judge each Class separately, positions 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> will enter the relevant Championship. Champion and Reserve Champion will qualify for the Champion of Champions Show in October. For example, the Show jumping class will be judged, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> will qualify in their relevant Championship section eg Part-bred. Once we have all PB 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Class results, they will go head to head for the Champion and Reserve Champion for the PB section.

All Champion and Reserve Champions from all 3 shows, will go forward to the Champion of Champions Show.

**Champion of Champions 3<sup>rd</sup> October** - The three Judges will jointly decide the CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS.

These will be selected from the CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPIONS from all three photo shows of 2020.

### **Prize Money**

All prize funds shall be paid via PayPal or Bank Transfer within 14 days post the Champion of Champions Show.

### **Trails & Videos**

Should you wish to participate in any trail / video class/s within this show you do so at your own risk. The ApHC UK Ltd is not responsible for any accident however caused. The schedule has been created to cater for the complete novice to the advanced members and their horses. We want you to participate, enjoy it and have fun but in doing so be safe.

We are aware many owners will not have such obstacles to create a trail course, we understand improvisation maybe required.

Use buckets for cones, logs for poles and a rubber mat / rug or similar for bridge. Please take into consideration the weather i.e. the wind when executing your trail pattern.

Regarding pole/log stride distances we recommend:

The space for walking over poles be - 20-24" (40-60cm).

The space for trot/jog be - 3' to 3'6" (90 to 105cm).

The spacing for lope/collective canter be 6' to 7' (1.8 to 2.1m).

The space between cones for walking be 4ft.

The space between cones for trotting/jogging be 6ft.
