RIDDEN PATTERNS

Pattern 1

Show horse stood still from front, side rear. Walk away 10 metres, jog/ trot half a circle before returning on centre track. Stand and turn 45 degrees to camera for judging to be complete.

Pattern 2

Show horse stood still from front, side rear. Walk away 10 metres, complete a figure of eight at trot. Return on centre track. Walk before starting point, stand and turn 45 degrees to camera for judging to be complete.

Pattern 3 Open show but must include:

Standing for 3-5 seconds at start and finish. Walking on both reins, lope/trot on both reins and lope/collected canter on both reins.

Pattern 4 Open show but must include:

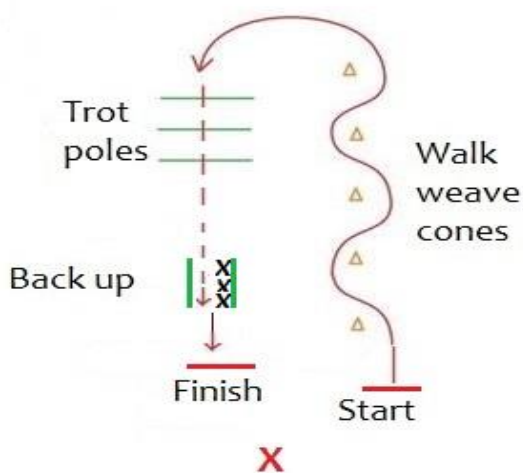
Standing for 3-5 seconds at the start and finish. Walking on both reins, lope/trot on both reins and lope/collected canter on both reins and one extension.

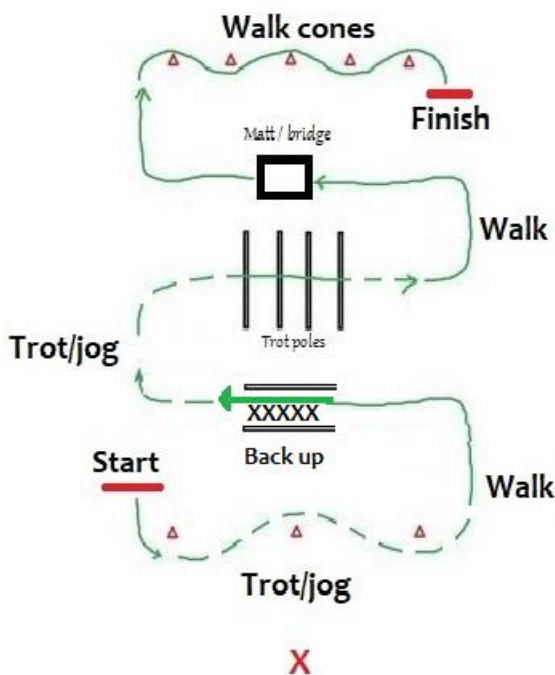
TRAIL PATTERN 1 - ULTIMATE NOVICE HORSE



1. WALK WEAVE CONES
2. TROT/JOG 3 POLES
3. TROT INTO CHUTE – TO HALT
4. BACK UP 3 STRIDES
5. WALK TO FINISH.

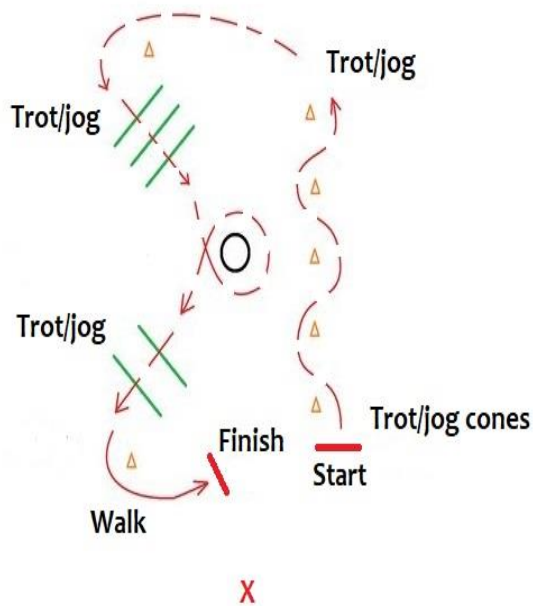
TRAIL PATTERN 2 – NOVICE HORSE



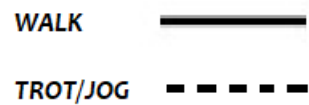
1. WALK FROM START
2. TROT/JOG WEAVE CONES
3. WALK IN TO CHUTE
4. BACK UP 4 STRIDES
5. WALK OUT OF CHUTE AND TROT/JOG
6. TROT/JOG 4 POLES
7. WALK AT TURN
8. WALK MATT/BRIDGE
9. WALK CONES TO FINISH

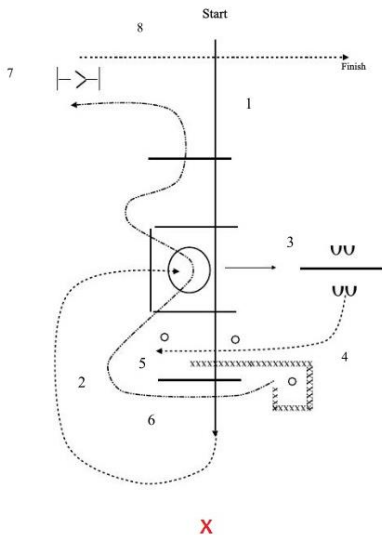
TRAIL PATTERN 3 – INTERMEDIATE HORSE



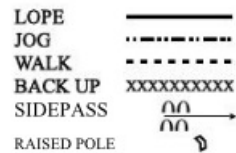
1. WEAVE CONES AT TROT/JOG
2. TROT/JOG 4 POLES
3. TROT/JOG 360* AROUND MARKER
4. TROT/JOG POLES
5. WALK AT MARKER TO FINISH



TRAIL PATTERN 4 – OPEN



1. Lope over poles
2. Walk into box turn left 630*
3. Sidepass left straddling pole to half way
4. Walk into chute
5. Back up as shown
6. Jog over poles to gate
7. Work gate with right hand
8. Walk to finish
