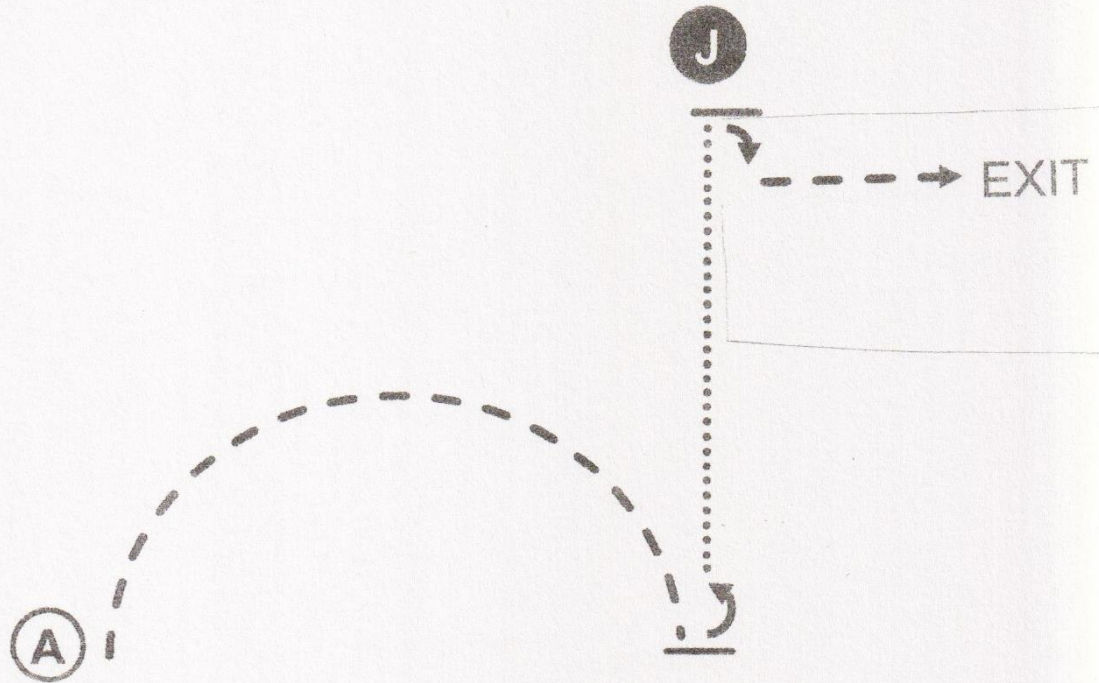
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**Inhand & Ridden Trail, Ranch Riding, Pleasure, Western

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Trail Training by the judge to take place before Trail classes

Class 67 Youth Handler up to age 12 yrs



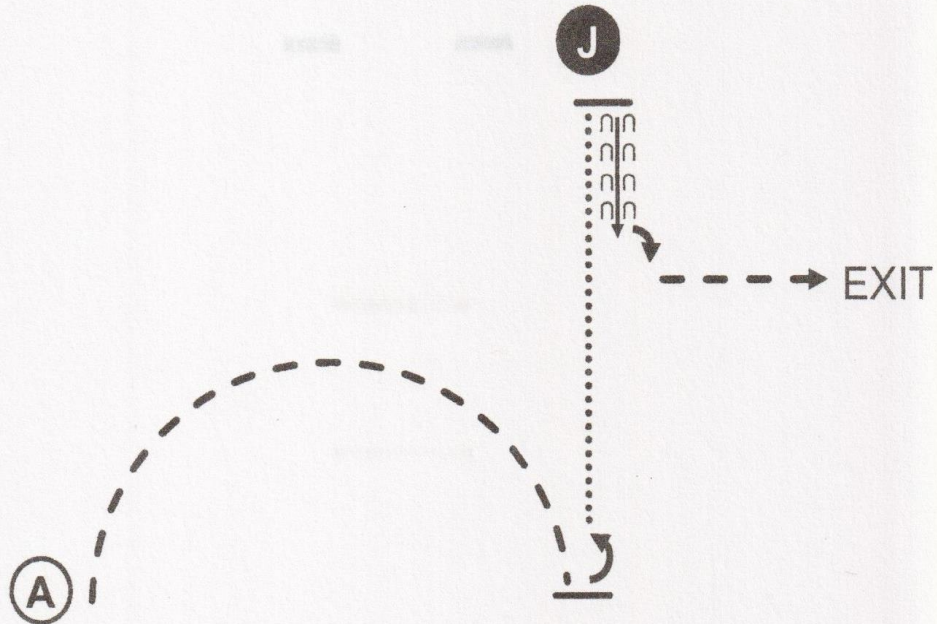
Be ready at A.

1. Trot a half circle and halt when even with A.
2. Turn 180° ($1/2$) to the right.
3. Walk to the judge.
4. Halt and set up for inspection.
5. Turn 90° ($1/4$) to the right and trot straight away.

Pattern complete.

Class 68 Youth Handler ages 13 to 18 yrs

Class 69 Adult Handler age 18 yrs+

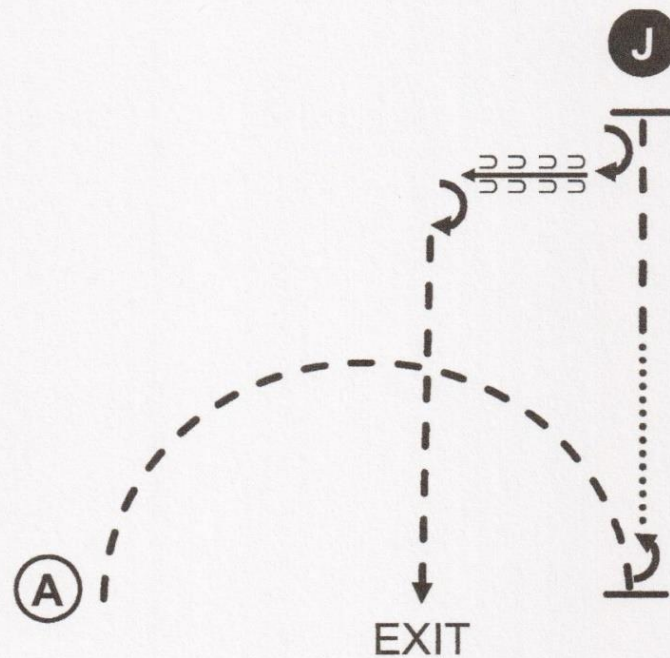


Be ready at A.

1. Trot a half circle and halt when even with A.
2. Turn 180° ($1/2$) to the right.
3. Walk to the judge.
4. Halt and set up for inspection.
5. After inspection, back 4 steps.
6. Turn 90° ($1/4$) to the right and trot straight away.

Pattern complete.

Class 70 – Showmanship



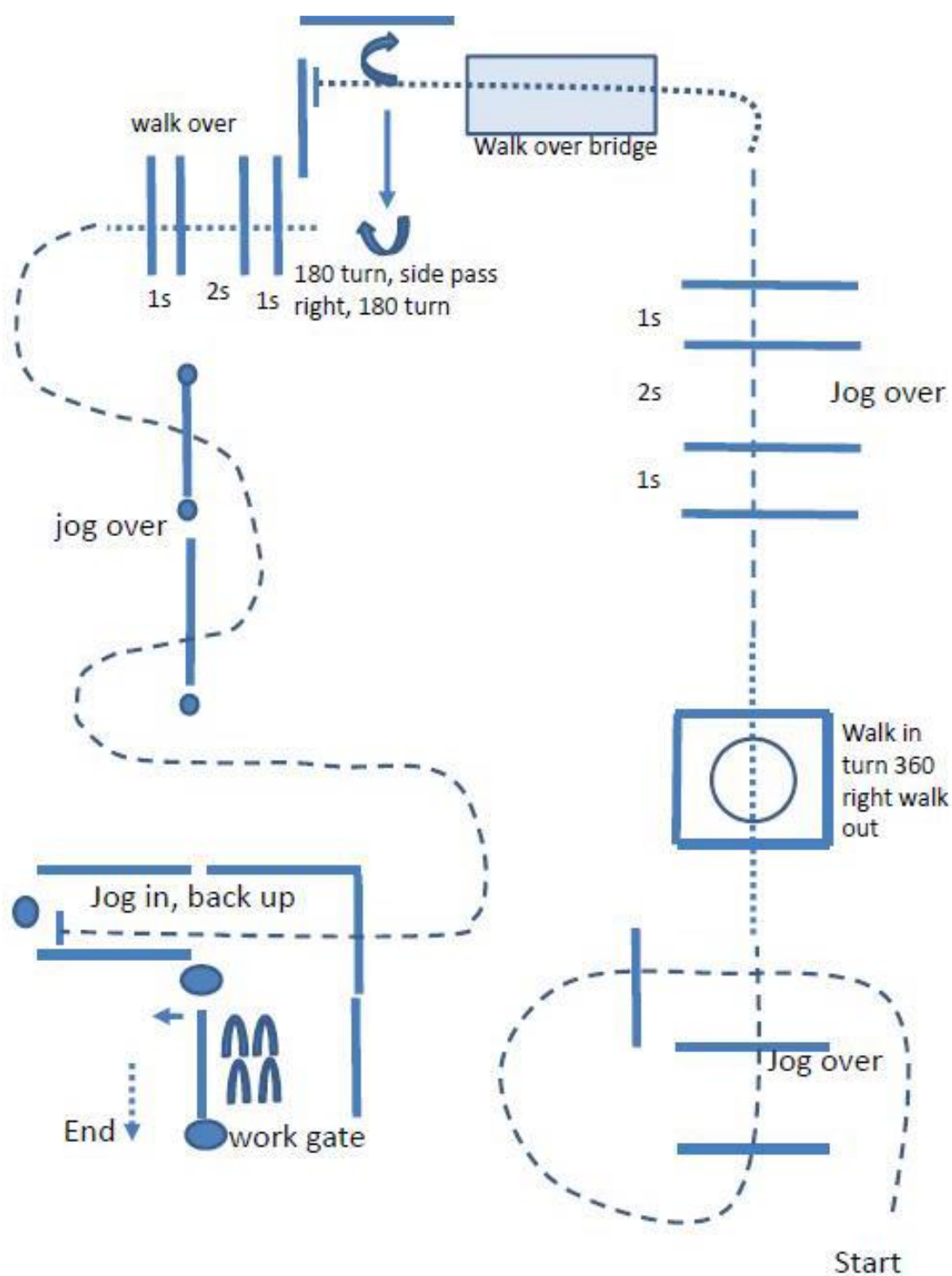
Be ready at A.

1. Trot a half circle and halt when even with A.
2. Turn 180° (1/2) to the right.
3. Walk halfway to judge, then trot halfway to judge.
4. Halt and set up for inspection.
5. After inspection, turn 90° (1/4) to the right.
6. Back one horse length.
7. Turn 90° (1/4) to the right and trot straight away.

Pattern complete.

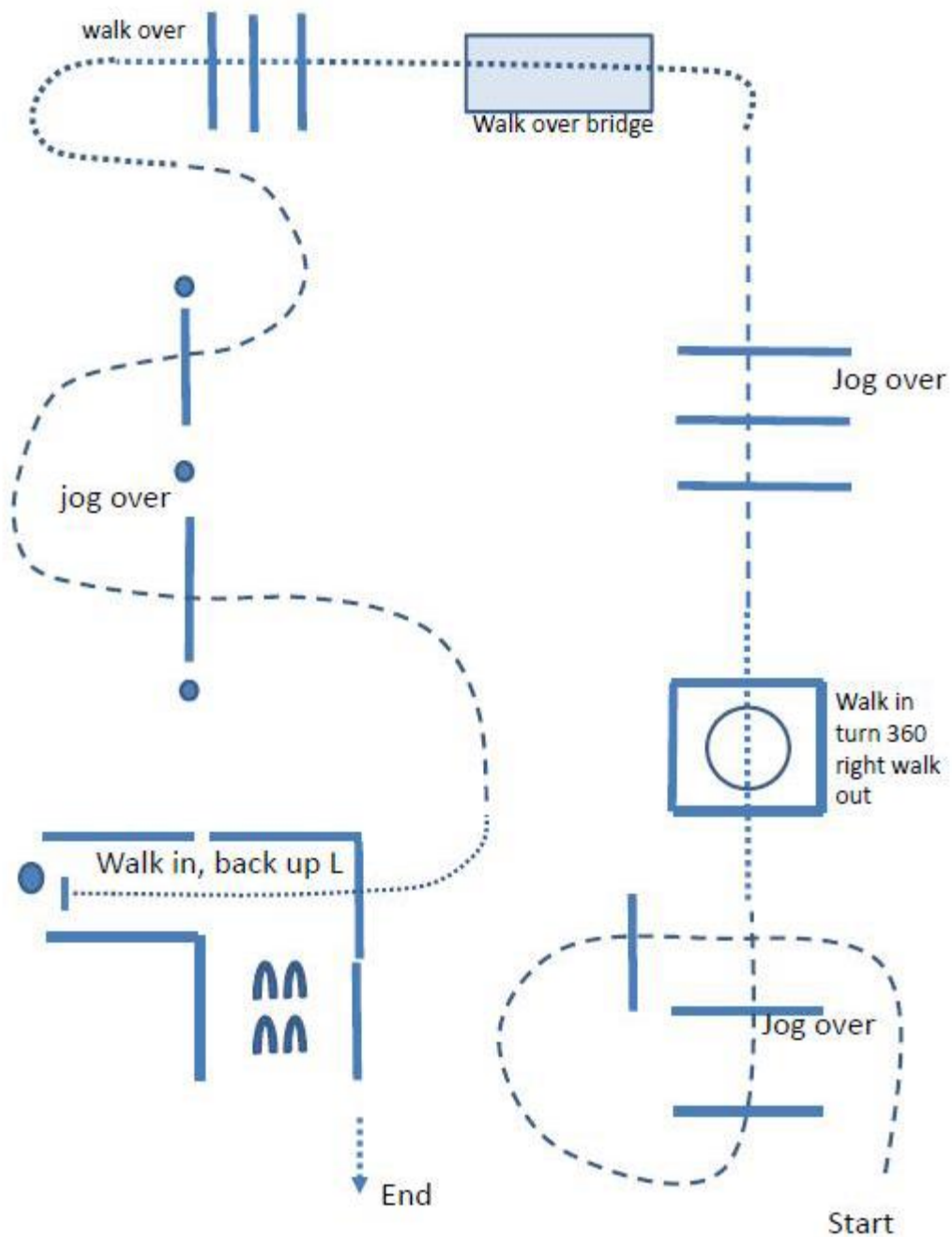
Class 71 – Inhand Trail – English/Western tack

(Training class/clinic with the judge before the Trail classes)



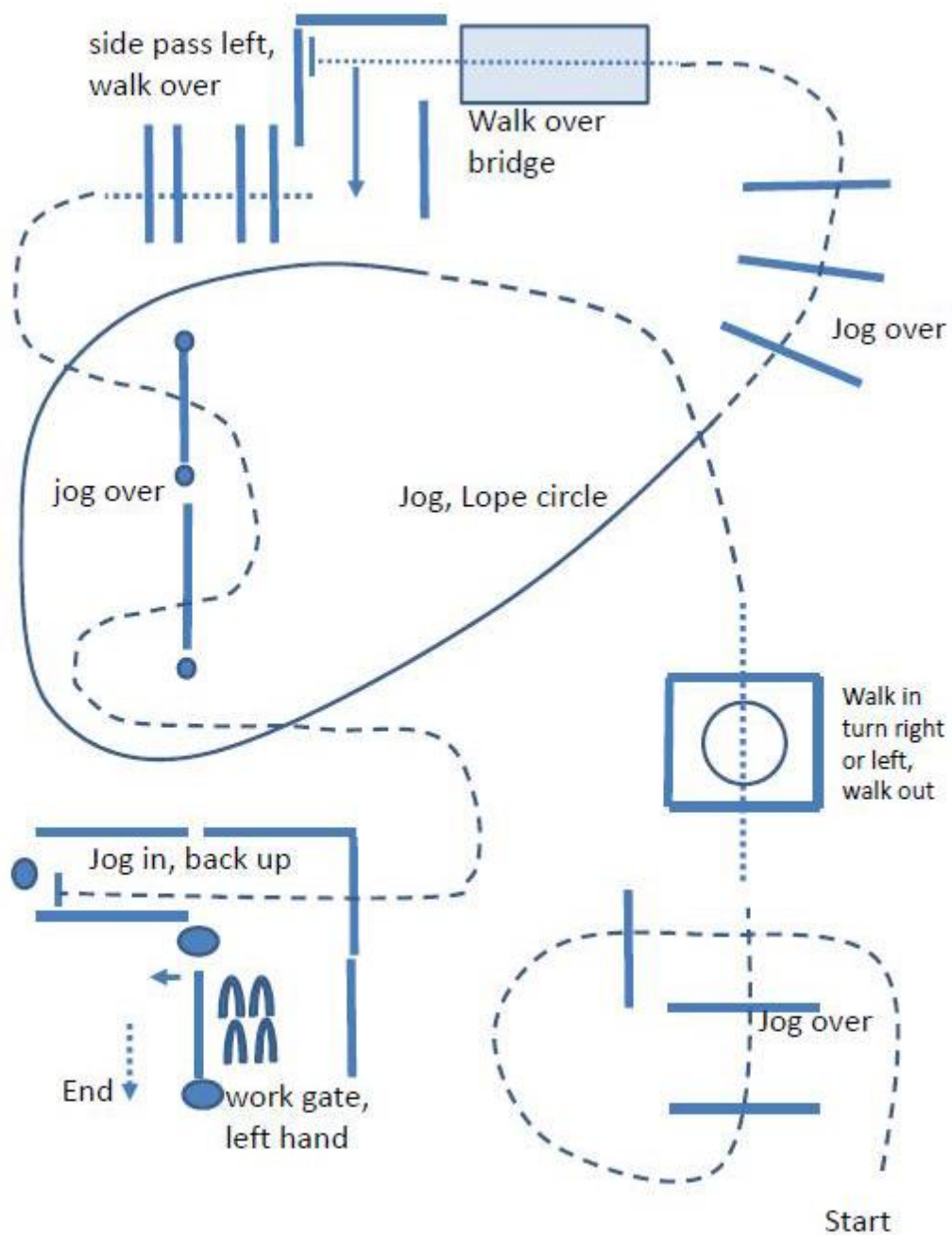
Class 72 Youth Trail Ridden – walk/jog

Class 75 Novice Trail – walk/jog

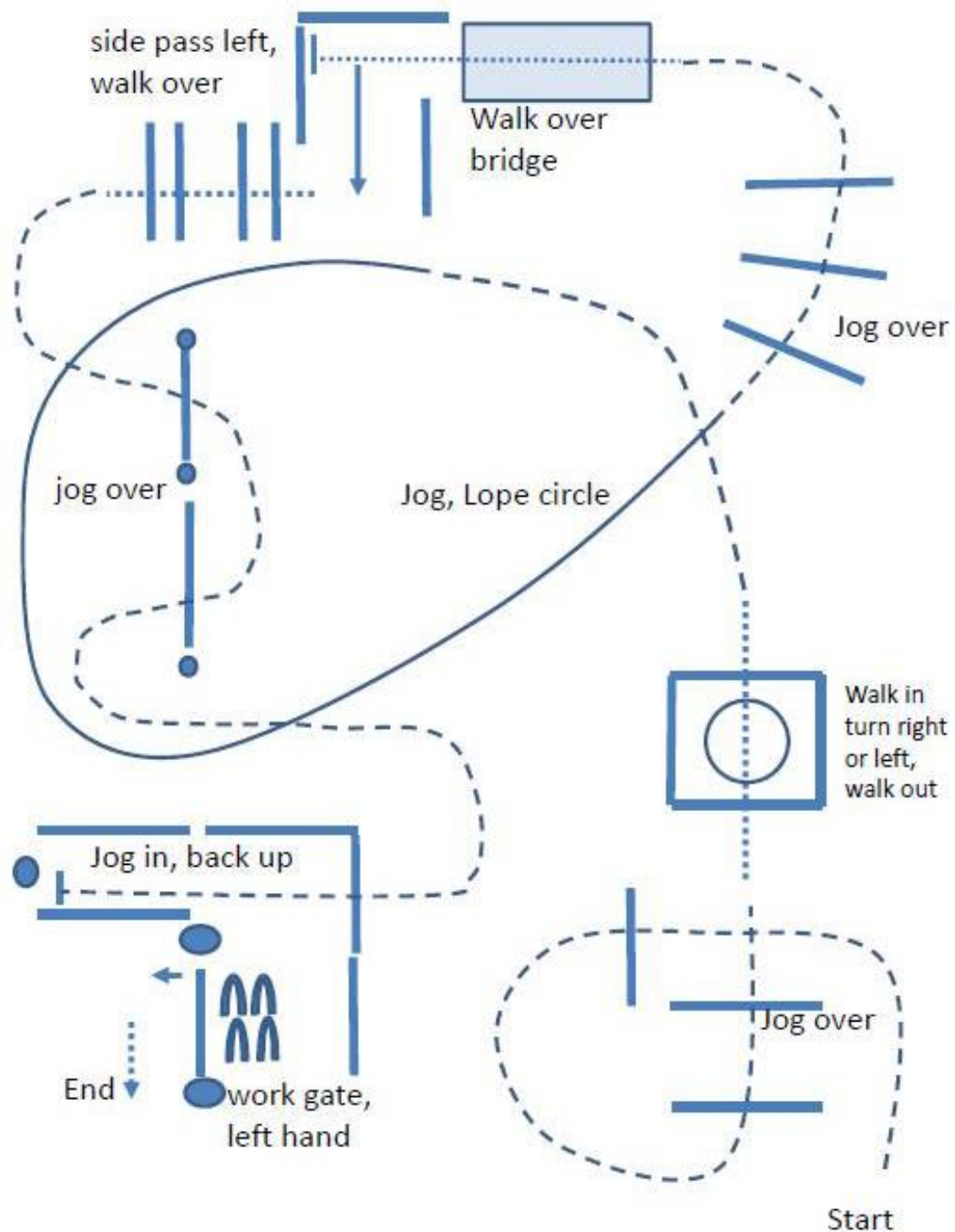


Class 73 Ridden Trail, Have a go (English/Western tack) - includes lope

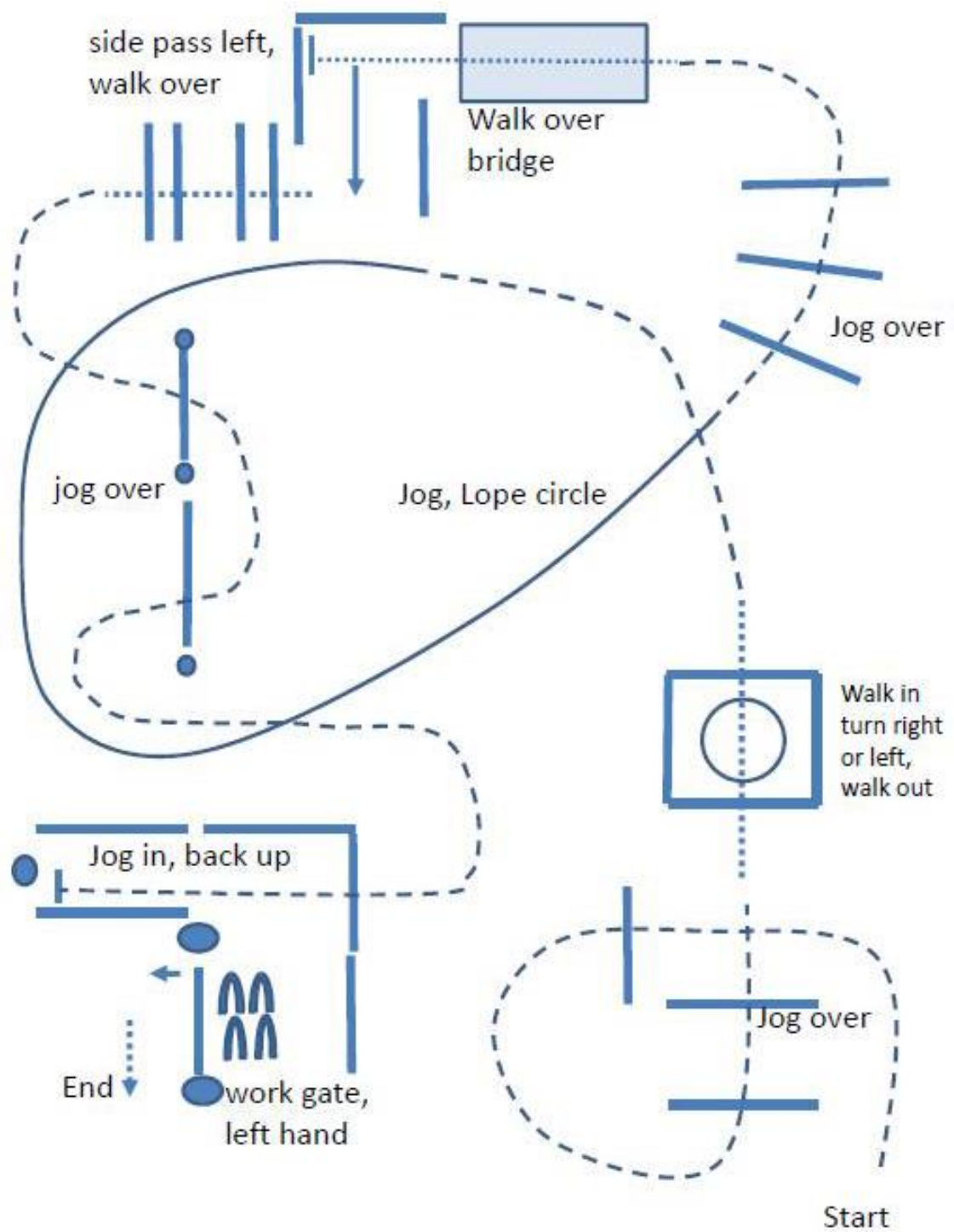
Class 74 Green Horse Trail – Any age



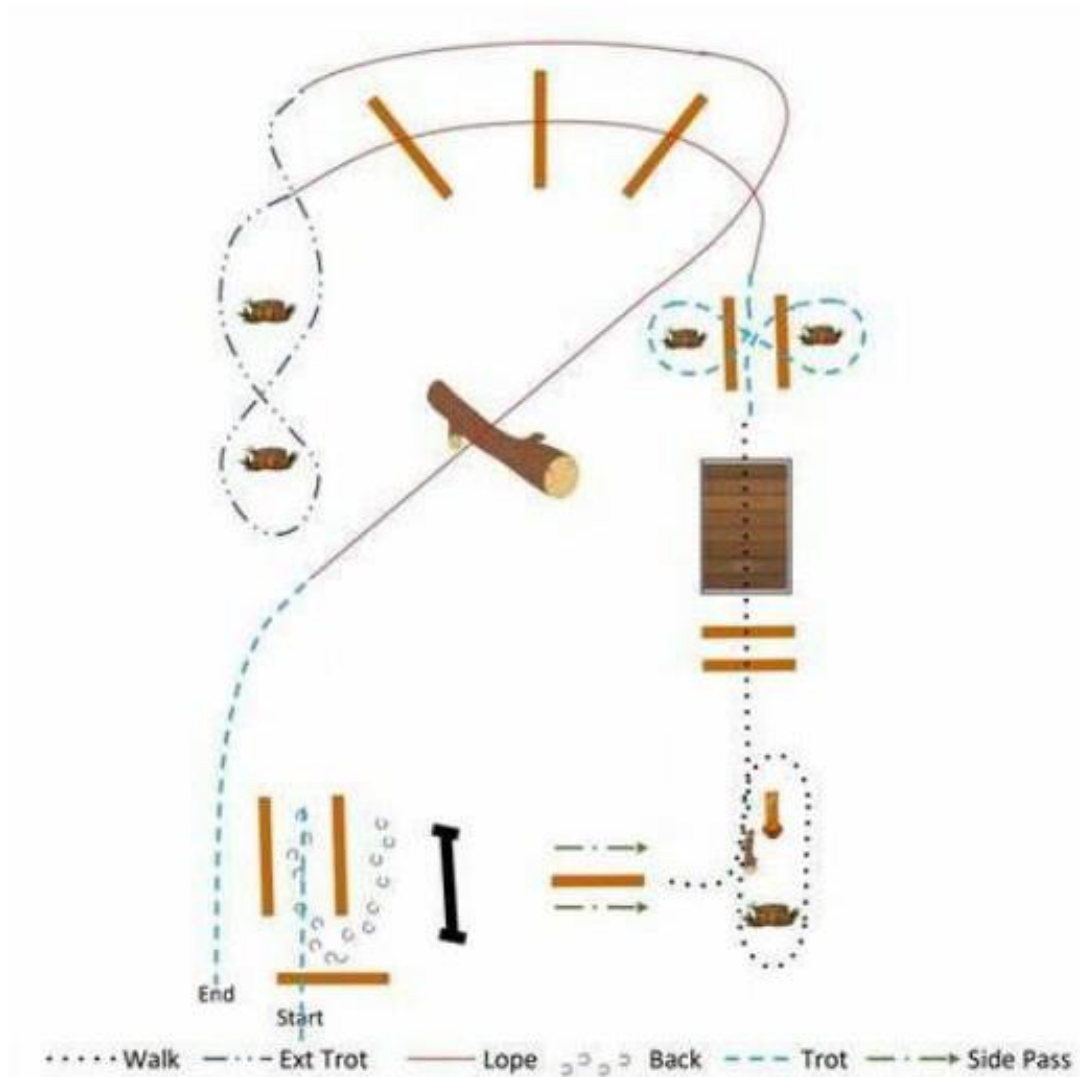
Class 76 Open Trail – includes lope



Class 77 Trail – All ages includes lope



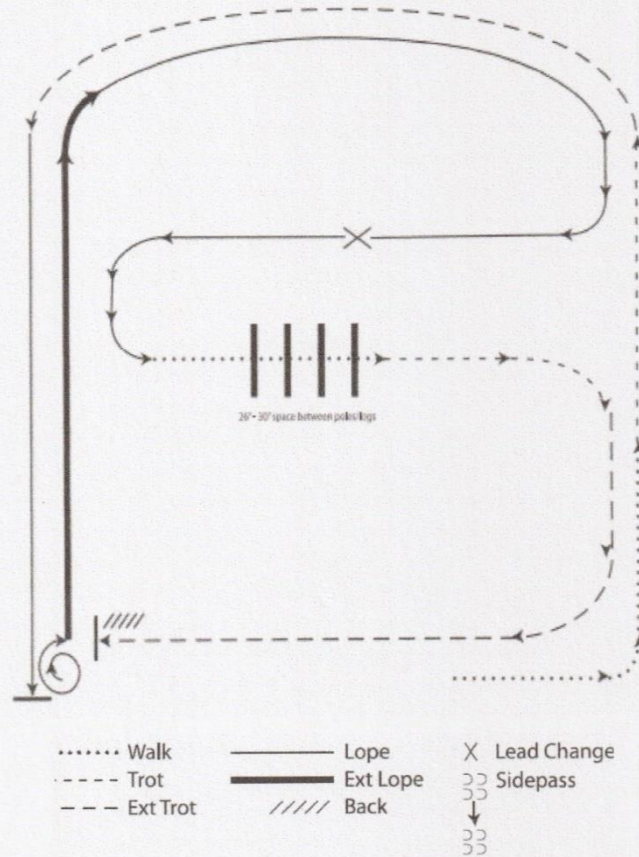
Class 78 Ranch Trail



1. Start by trotting over the first log and into the chute and back around the U until you are in position for the gate.
2. Open and close the gate using a left hand push.
3. Side past right past log
4. Complete log drag at walk or trot (Youth check mail at mail box and return it)
5. Walk over logs and onto the bridge
6. Trot figure of eight
7. Lope left lead over the logs and once past the logs break to an extended trot
8. Extend trot around the markers
9. Lope right lead around logs and continue to lope over the jump then break to a trot and exit

Note: For the youth members, item 4 is not a drag

Class 79 Ranch Riding – includes trail (poles)

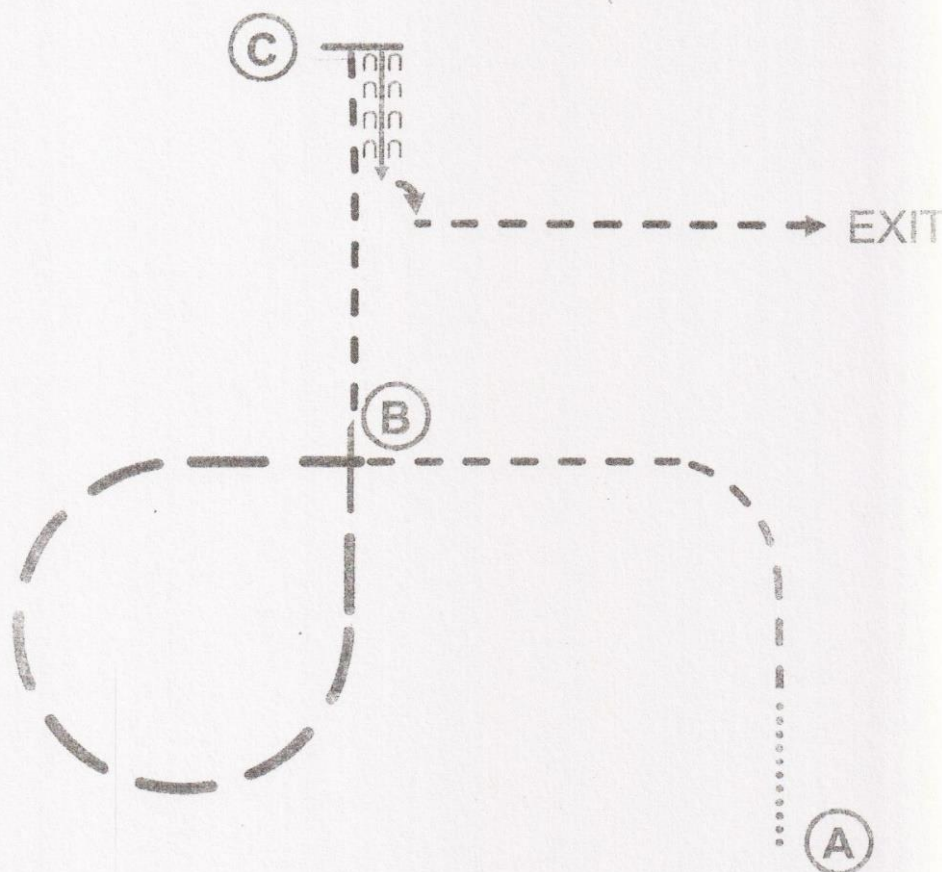


RANCH RIDING PATTERN 2

1. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extended trot
4. Left lead lope
5. Stop, 1 ½ turn right
6. Extended lope
7. Collect to working lope-right lead
8. Change leads (simple or flying)
9. Walk
10. Walk over logs
11. Trot
12. Extended trot
13. Stop and back

Class 83 Youth Ridden Western up to 12 yrs

Class 92 Walk Jog Horsemanship



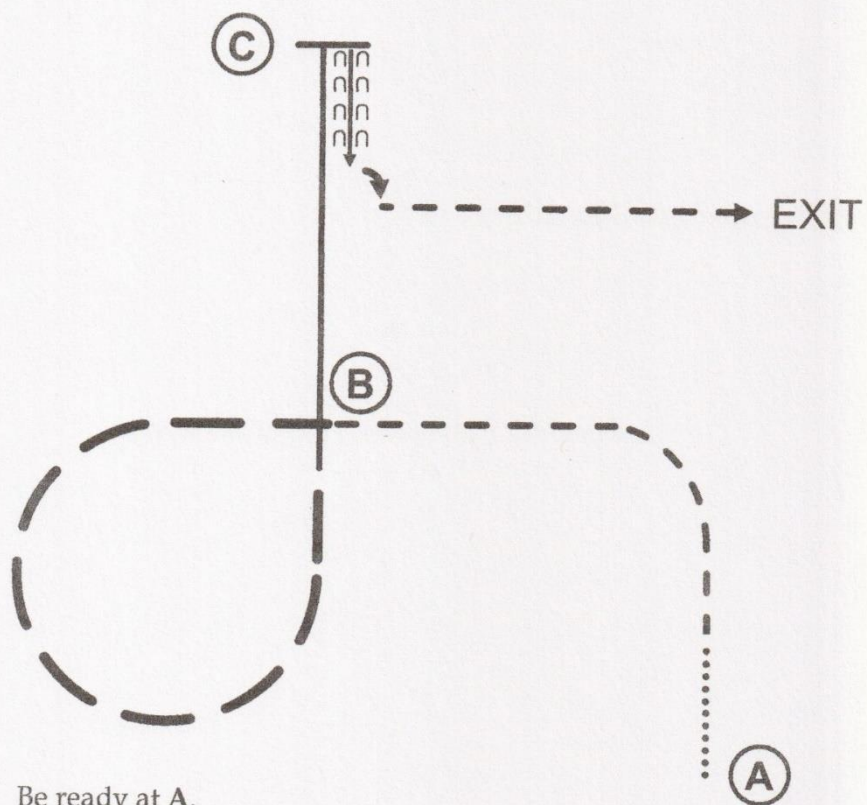
Be ready at A.

1. Walk two horse lengths.
2. Jog toward B.
3. At B, extended jog circle to the left.
4. At B, break down to a jog toward C.
5. At C, stop and back 1 horse length.
6. 90 to the right.
7. Jog to exit.

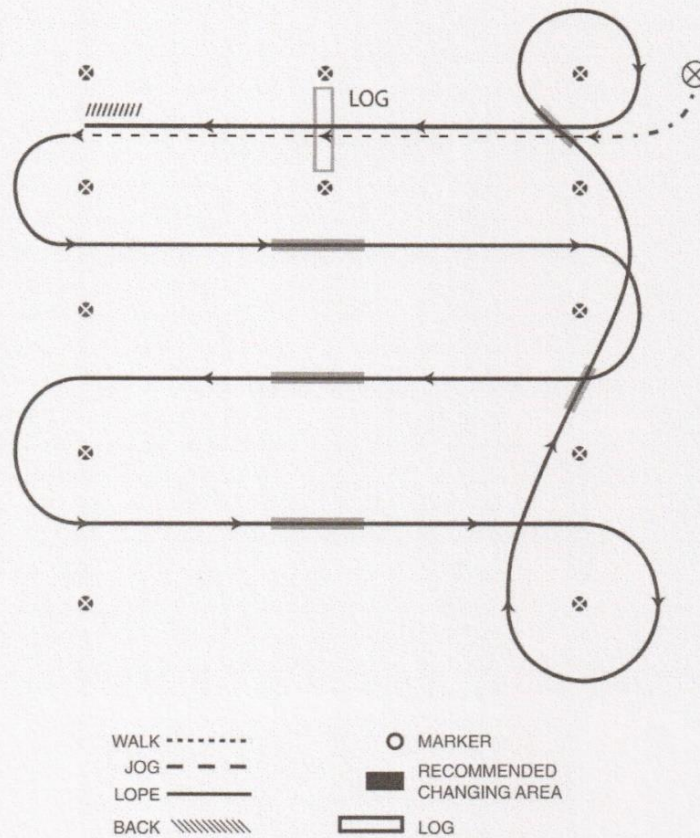
Class 94 Horsemanship



Be ready at A.

1. Walk two horse lengths.
2. Jog, jog toward B.
3. At B, extended jog a circle to the left.
4. Lope right lead toward C.
5. At C, stop, back one horse length.
6. Turn 90° (1/4) to the right.
7. Jog to exit.

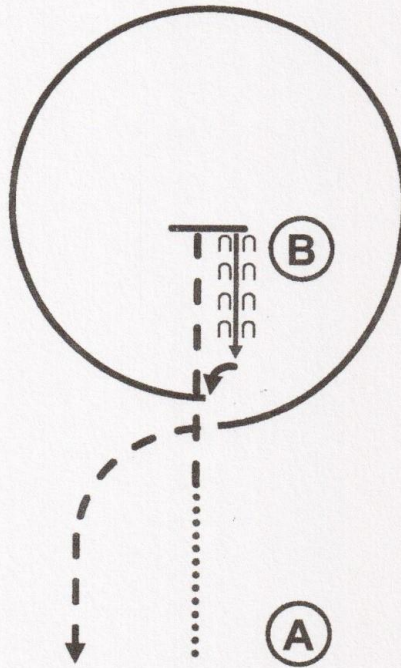
Class 91 Green Horse Western Riding – walk, jog, lope



GREEN WESTERN RIDING PATTERN 2

1. Walk, transition to jog, jog over log
2. Transition to left lead lope
3. First crossing change
4. Second crossing change
5. Third crossing change
6. Circle & first line change
7. Second line change & circle
8. Lope over log
9. stop & back

Class 96 Hunt seat Equitation



Be ready a A.

1. Walk two horse lengths then posting trot on the left diagonal to B.
2. Halt at B, and back approximately one horse length.
3. Perform a 90° (1/4) turn to the left.
4. Canter a circle on the right lead.
5. At the close of the circle, sitting trot until even with A.

Pattern complete after you pass A.
